EDUCATIONAL TOOLS:

World Map: Found at the beginning of each book, helps children understand where they live in relation to the story location. Focus on geography & culture.

Did you Know? Fact or Fiction Page: Is found at the end of each book encouraging history, science, social studies, and geographical learning. Kids find out what is real & what isn't in the story.

Real Activities based in Canada: It takes the reality of a child's activities and creates bedtime stories that use those skills. It encourages physical activity as well as reading and imagination.

Parent, Child Connection: It shows the connection for parents & children about how special reading at bedtime is and how it allows parents to engage in a child's life on a daily basis.
